Attributes of a good prefect

A prefect role is one of significant responsibility. In order to be an effective prefect, you need to:

- Be 100% reliable i.e. always turn up at the right time and in the right place to fulfil your duties e.g. supporting the staff during school events and during Wednesday morning registrations; supporting the Head Boy & Girl during major school events etc.
- Be visibly committed to the school community and ethos i.e. your conduct and appearance should provide a consistently positive role model for others
- Have the respect of your peers, so that you can influence them
- Have the respect of teachers, so they will listen to your suggestions
- Display effective leadership and organisational skills, so that you can get things done through working with others
- Have good team working and interpersonal skills so that you can support and encourage others
